



Ohio Township Association Leadership Academy

The Ohio Township Association Leadership Academy (OTALA) is a joint effort between the Ohio Township Association (OTA); OSU Extension: Office of Community Development; and Miami University's Center for Public Management and Regional Affairs. It is designed for elected officials, township professional staff, and for appointed individuals who serve on township committees, commissions, boards or task forces.

The purpose of the Academy is to provide useful programs that will enhance the leadership and decision making skills of the township leadership team. A leadership diploma will be presented to each individual who

successfully completes the program. The Leadership Academy is open to all active and associate members of the OTA.

The Academy curriculum includes 11 workshops to be completed in three calendar years. All participants must take the general workshop and complete six elective courses.

Classes for the Academy will be offered at each of the OTA's annual conferences.

Signing up for the Leadership Academy allows us to track your progress. If you began the Academy in a previous year, you do not need to fill out another form.
