- COURSE TITLE:** Incident Management / Unified Command for WMD/ Terrorism Incidents (NIMS) (MGT-313)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Delivered by **National Emergency Response and Rescue Training Center (NERRTC)**, **Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX)**. This course focuses on the special challenges faced by senior-level incident management personnel in dealing with a mass casualty terrorist incident. A combination of classroom lecture and scenario-based team exercises will reinforce the information presented in various simulations, videos, and case histories. Upon completion of the course, key personnel will possess the skills required to effectively coordinate emergency response efforts to a WMD event including the ability to integrate communications and planning among fire, rescue, emergency medical service, law enforcement, emergency management, public sector, local government, State, and Federal agencies.

This IM/UC (MGT 313) course complies with the NIMS National Standard Curriculum Training Development Guidance, of October 2005, and has been deemed to be both "ICS-300 compliant and equivalent training" by the DHS Office of Grants and Training (G&T) in conjunction with the DHS NIMS Integration Center (NIC).
