Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents

All Mid-level Management Federal/State/Local/Tribal/Private Sector & Nongovernmental personnel to include should take ICS-300, including:

Persons serving as command staff, shift commanders, section chiefs, strike team leaders, task force leaders, unit leaders, division/group supervisors, branch directors, and multi-agency coordination system/emergency operations center staff.*

- * ICS Staffing and organization to include: reporting and working relationships and information flow.
- * Transfer of Command
- * Unified Command functions in a multi-jurisdictional or multi-agency incident
- * ICS forms
- * Resource Management and Ordering & Typing Resources
- * Interagency mission planning and procurement
- * Writing an Incident Action Plan (IAP)
- * Planning meeting process to include pre-strategy and operation meetings
- * Unified Command vs Area Command
