COURSE TITLE: **Emergency Operations Plans (MGT 383)**

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This 8-hour planning and management-level course is designed to provide first responders with the knowledge and skills to develop an emergency operations plan (EOP) for their local jurisdiction or region. Participants are provided with knowledge on the planning process, the different types of emergency operations plan formats, and the components of each. Participants engage in scenarios that are designed to reinforce the lessons learned and to enable them to determine the best format for their particular jurisdiction and to organize the various planning components into an EOP.

PARTICIPANT CRITERIA:

The primary audience for this course is Emergency Management, Fire Service, Law Enforcement, Public Health, Government Administrators and Healthcare.

PERQUISITE:

The following prerequisite courses are recommended but not required:

IS 100 Introduction to Incident Command System, ICS-100

IS 200 ICS for Single Resources & Initial Action Incidents

IS 700 National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction

IS 701 NIMS Multiagency Coordination System (MACS) Course

IS 800 National Response Framework, An Introduction
