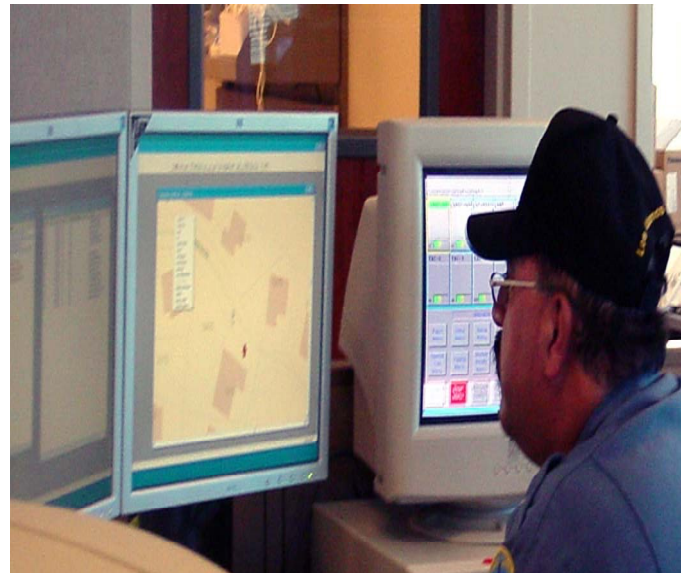

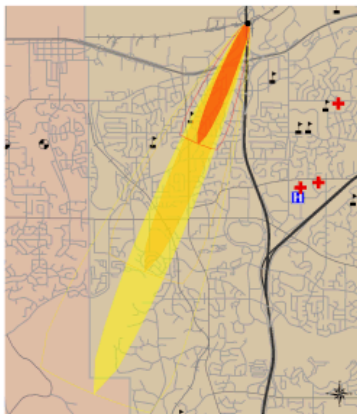


Course Description:

The *Introduction to the Computer-Aided Management of Emergency Operations (CAMEO) Suite* course provides performance-level training to emergency response personnel, principally by training representatives of local and state agencies who respond to intentional acts (such as bombings; hostage situations; biological, chemical and nuclear attacks; and arson; natural occurrence (such as hurricanes, tornadoes, disease outbreaks, range/forest fires, and floods); or accidental events (such as chemical spills, explosions, train derailments, and structure fires).
