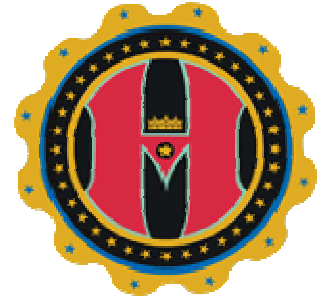

What is ROGREMS:

- **ROGREMS** (Regional Emergency Operation Center, OKI, GIS, Regional Emergency Mapping System) is an online tool that allows the user to identify critical infrastructure and key resources within the immediate 12 county, three state planning region encompassing Southwest Ohio, Southeast Indiana and Northern Kentucky. ROGREMS offers users a common operating picture/situational awareness and a series of tools to help prepare for, respond to and/or recover from a large scale emergency or disaster. ROGREMS also offers functionality to help users with special event planning.

It allows you to:

- Identify local resources
- Determine whether a particular facility or building is in danger following a chemical leak or spill
- Gather information/intelligence about a particular emergency utilizing social media
- View live Artemis camera feeds

It allows you to (Cont.):

- Users can view live feeds (such as Artemis cameras) in an around an emergency scene (helpful in determining evacuation capacities/routes).
- Perform many additional functions during emergencies/exercises/planned events.
