Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings Awareness Course Description

This 4-hour course provides basic instruction on response procedures for terrorist incidents involving energetic materials (explosives and incendiaries). The course includes classroom presentations that address potential terrorist bombing targets in U.S. communities, common military and commercial explosives available to terrorists, Improvised explosive devices (IEDs), and response procedures that support safe and effective operations during bombing incidents.

Course will run from 0800 to 1130 hrs.

Prevention & Response to Suicide Bombings Course Description:

This 4-hour course provides steps that individual emergency responders can take in order to recognize the pre-attack indicators and assist in the prevention of suicide bombings and safely and effectively respond to a suicide bombing once it has occurred. It also familiarizes students with improvised explosive devices (IEDs) and explosive materials typically used in suicide bombings.
