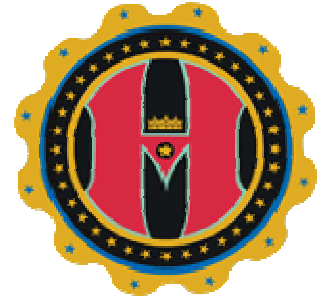
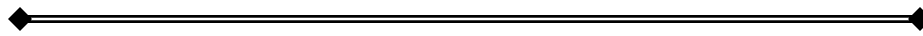

Course Description:

This course will introduce participants to the WebEOC operating platform. WebEOC is the emergency operation and communication software for the SOSINK region. It provides a common platform for all municipalities and disciplines to operate on. Participants will learn about the present and future functionality of the SOSINK WebEOC. Participants will be registered in the WebEOC system and learn how to use the system during an emergency. The participants will learn how their individual logs become part of the larger local and regional operational picture.

At the end of the course, students will be able to:

- Log in to WebEOC during an activation
- Add Additional positions to their user profile

At the end of the course, students will be able to (Cont.):

- Function in WebEOC during an EOC activation
- Be able to keep a position log and post reports to the significant events log
- Request and assign resources
- Assign and complete tasks
- Understand how the local and regional operational picture is formed in WebEOC
