OKI EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING REPORT

President's Report (Ed Humphrey) -

Motion to Cancel December 8, 2011 Executive Committee Meeting - Motion Passed.

Executive Director's Report (Mark Policinski) –

Mr. Policinski mentioned two upcoming open houses for the Eastern Corridor and the Martin Luther King Interchange off I-71.

Last week, a meeting of the M-70 (Marine 70 Corridor) met at OKI to discuss the use of resources along the Ohio River. This has been an outcome of the Freight Working Group that began 6 years ago.

Mr. Policinski thanked Mike Juengling for his 21 years on the Board. Mr. Juengling has represented Butler County in a number of capacities and this is his last meeting representing Butler County.

Legislative Report (Brian Cunningham) –

Mr. Cunningham reported that in Washington DC, Senator Boxer along several other Senators has proposed a 2-year (FY 2012 and 2013) \$83.5B piece of legislation for Transportation. It was passed out of her committee 18-0. Now it faces three more committee hearings (Finance; Banking & Housing (includes Urban Transit); and Commerce & Transportation (Safety)). It will include NO earmarks, but does include \$1B annually for projects of national significance as well as \$1B annually for TIFIA type projects.

On the House side, House Speaker Boehner has a 6-year bill being proposed and hopes to have it through the committees by the end of the year.

Item #3 - OKI 2040 Regional Transportation Plan Update - Presentation #4 (Robyn Bancroft and Andy Reisor) - Safety and Congestion Management

Ms. Bancroft presented information related to road and railroad safety that needs to be considered as we look forward. What improvements need to happen to address a safer future?

Some statistics for our region that Ms. Bancroft shared included the following:

Older Drivers on the Road -

2005 - 223,512

2040 - 406,473

80% increase of older drivers on the road by 2040

Crashes	All	Age 65+
Intersection	30%	40%
Angle	14%	23%
Daylight	69%	83%
